
## The 12 Annual Festival of Trees at the Bedford Area Welcome Center

Food for Kids was recently awarded a \$9,500 grant from the Bedford Community Health Foundation. This grant is certainly appreciated and will definitely be utilized as we continue to serve food insecure elementary students in our community throughout the 2020-2021 school year.





Also, Food For Kids recently received Bedford County Cares Act Grant Funding in the amount of \$10,000. This funding will assist our organization in replacing lost income due to the inability to host our normal fundraising activities during this pandemic. We were unable to host our three Country Breakfasts this summer, or our annual Steel Drum Concert, or a Bluegrass concert that was being planned.

Although our organization has been fortunate to receive some recent grant funding, our ability to continue to serve food insecure children wouldn't be possible without God's blessing and each and every one of you! Community support has been, and will continue to be, the backbone of our organization. Due to the circumstances that many families are experiencing this year, the need to feed food insecure children is greater than ever. Our estimated cost to support one child is \$9 a week, \$36 a month or \$324 a year. It is expected that the number of children we serve this school year will increase to up to 400 per week.
